

AGREEMENTS

I have read and understand the following (initial each line item):

- _____ I, parent/guardian, hereby certify that to the best of my knowledge, my child is able to safely participate in the program activities for which he or she has been registered.
- _____ I, parent/guardian, give permission for my child to travel to various field trips in an authorized Ware Academy vehicle. I understand that I will be notified in advance of all planned field trips.
- _____ I, parent/guardian, hereby authorize Ware Academy Summer Camp personnel, acting as an agent of the Program, to act in *loco parentis* with respect to emergency medical treatment for my child's health and well-being. I also agree to be responsible for any cost associated with such care.
- _____ I, parent/guardian, grant permission for my child to be included in Ware Academy Summer Camp pictures, and give permission for those pictures to be used for displays, brochures, and promotional materials with no compensation to my child or me.
- _____ I, parent/guardian, hereby authorize Ware Academy to aid my child in the application of sunscreen and/or bug spray.
- _____ I, parent/guardian, agree to hold harmless Ware Academy, its Board of Trustees, administration, faculty, camp staff or any affiliates of same (persons or organizations acting on behalf of Ware Academy) jointly and/or severally in the event of accident or mishap.
- _____ The Camp Director reserves the right to send home any child who puts himself/herself or others at risk, including risk of emotional or physical injury.
- _____ The Ware Academy Summer Camp Program agrees to notify the parent/guardian whenever the child becomes ill. The parent/guardian will arrange to have the child picked up as soon as possible when requested by camp personnel.
- _____ **Medication Administration Policy – Department of Health and Virginia Department of Social Services**
- Students may not bring any type of medication to school. This includes both prescription and over-the-counter medication such as cough drops, cold or sinus pills, decongestants, medicated ointments, etc.
 - The school must be notified if you have given your child any medicine before arriving at camp. This allows staff to be aware of any possible side effects that may occur.
 - In the event it is necessary for your child to be medicated during camp hours a parent/ guardian must come to Ware Academy to administer the medication. Under no circumstances is a camper allowed to administer medicine to themselves, including cough drops.
